Katniss Everdeen volunteers in the games to save her sister, resulting in a brutal and traumatizing experience.

The Amulet of Samarkand by Johnathon Stroud

Eleven-year-old Nathaniel is a magician in training, sold to the government at a young age and forced to live as an apprentice. When Nathaniel is humiliated by ruthless magician Simon Lovelace and betrayed by his master, he vows revenge. Nathaniel summons 5,000-year-old djinni Bartimaeus to avenge Simon by stealing the Amulet of Samarkand, but he ends up in a dangerous and deadly situation.
