Overview

I agree that I will abide by WHSPA's BYOD Policy and that I will:

- Use the DoE's WI-Fi network for learning purposed only
- Use my device during school activities following the direction of my teacher
- Use my <u>own</u> Student Portal credentials to connect to the Wi-Fi and never share my details with others.
- Have my device charged and ready for use for each school day
- Be vigilant and not give my personal information to strangers
- Not attempt to hack or bypass any hardware or software security which has been implemented by the DoE and WHSPA
- Not use my own device to knowingly search for, link to, access or send any item that
 offensive, pornographic, threatening, abusive, defamatory or bullying
- Report any inappropriate behaviour or inappropriate material to my teacher
- Understand that all my activity on the internet is recorded and that these records may be used in investigations, court proceedings or for other legal reasons
- Acknowledge that WHSPA cannot be help responsible for any damage to or theft of my device
- Read and understand the limitations of the manufacturer's warranty on my device, both in coverage and exemptions (The school with be limited in supporting your devices hardware issues)
- Read the BYOD Device Requirements (see below) and ensure my device meets the minimum specifications

Apple iPads as well as Android Tablets if used in conjunction with a good wireless keyboard, are suitable for students in Years 7 through 10. However, these types of devices are **not recommended** for Year 11 and 12 students and / or students who need to use high performance programs such as Adobe applications.
